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CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Showmanship

ASSOCIATION

Judged on the horse's groomed appearance, rider's ability to handle the horse leading with a halter and performing a given pattern (setting up horse squarely, walking, trotting, setting up for judge's inspection and correctly switching, pivoting on hindquarter)

English Equitation

Judged on the rider's ability to handle the horse, riding in english tack

English Pleasure

Judged on the horse's functional correctness, quality of movement, good attitude and manners, in English tack

Champagne Game

A classic competition of steady hands and superb horsemanship. The rider carries a Champagne class full of water, the rider at the end of the class with the most water left in their glass wins!

Egg N Spoon Game

Another competition to display your balance skills while riding. The rider carries a spoon with an egg (no thumbs on the egg!). The last rider to keep the egg balanced on their spoon is the winner.

Bareback Equitation

Judged on the rider's performance, riding bareback with english or western bridle.

Costume Class

Create a costume for you and your horse (at least one horse MUST be included in entry). Pairs allowed also. If multiple exhibitors ride together each pays an entry fee. All exhibitors in same entry need to wear same back number.

Western Equitation

Judged on the rider's performance, riding in western tack.

Musical Cones

Run to the nearest cone when the music stops. Must go in same direction—no reversing once the music stops. Must continue to move forward when music is playing—cannot stop until music stops.

Barrels Race (Speed Event)

Race the classic cloverleaf pattern.

Flag Race (Speed Event)

Carry out a flag, place it in a bucket of sand on the barrel, pick up the second flag and carry it to the finish.

Pole Bending (Speed Event)

Pattern will be posted. This is a speed event.

Keyhole (Speed Event)

The keyhole race is a timed event that requires speed, obedience, and agility. The object is to complete the pattern correctly as quickly as possible, without stepping outside of the keyhole shape marked on the ground.

A FEW RULES

AGE: Rider's age on day of show.

ATTIRE: Helmets are required in all speed events (classes 38-57) and for entrants under age 18.

Boots, long pants and shirts (with sleeves) required for all classes (no tennis shoes or shorts, even in costume class). Show attire optional.

TACK: Horse must be shown in tack appropriate for the class. Humane training tack is allowed. Judge's opinion is final concerning use of questionable tack.

- Entrants riding in classes 9, 14, 19, 24 and 37 may not participate in any other Equitation/Pleasure class.
- The Walk-Trot, Walk/Jog classes are intended for novice riders to build show confidence, NOT for green horses.
- High Point is based on age-group classes. These are all classes except.
- Classes with 3 or fewer entrants may be combined or cancelled; large classes may be split at the discretion of show management.
- Bareback equitation classes may be ridden with english or western bridle no chaps or bareback pads allowed.
- Age 17 and under riders may NOT show stallions.
- Unruly and/or dangerous horses or riders will be excused.
- NO Refunds on scratches or on pre-registration fees.

That I have read and understand the following disclaimer: Warning: Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.
- 4. That I understand I am responsible for the actions of my horse or any horse procured for my participation, or of any such horse of my child or legal ward, whether the horse is mounted or unmounted.
- 5. That in no way is BCHA, its members, or the officers of BCHA responsible for any incident or injury resultant from or related to this event.
- 6. That I understand I am responsible for bodily injury or property damage which I or my child or legal ward should sustain while participating in this event or while traveling to or from this event.
- 7. That I am responsible for any time that I or my child or legal ward may lose from employment or school or other activity, and for medical expenses or any other expenses incurred because of such bodily injury or property damage; and that
